She found all that and more at Landis Place on King, a 55-plus apartment community at 239 W. King St. developed by Landis Quality Living, a division of Landis Communities.

Recently, a resident who grows orchids and is writing a book on the subject offered a demonstration on planting and care of the plants. A grant that helps support such resident events funded small pots and orchids for each of the program's 20 participants, Kushner says.

The community has an on-site Care Navigator focused on each resident's holistic health and helping them to thrive as they age in place. The Care Navigator is available as a trusted adviser to residents and their families, connecting them

to a variety of resources including transportation, home health care, medical providers, rehab therapy, social services, hospice care and wellness activities.

That's another reason Mc-Govern found Landis Place at King so appealing.

"Here at LPK I have an opportunity to have the help come in that I will need," she says, noting she could contract to have a nurse come in for medications or have someone clean her apartment. "I will still be independent. They give me the tools to get what I need. My main goal is to be very independent."

Other amenities at Landis Place on King include lounges on every floor, an exercise room, and a topfloor outdoor terrace where the social committee maintains a coffee and tea station and hosts cookouts and other themed events. The building also offers secured access with key fob entry to resident living areas and

41 interior parking spaces available for an additional monthly fee on a first-come, first-served basis.

And not to be forgotten is the thriving downtown community right at the doorstep.

It all combines to create an atmosphere where residents feel safe, secure and part of a greater community, both in Landis Place on King and beyond.

"I love it here," McGovern says. "I love being involved. I've always been a people person so it's nice to be among people and having a social life again." Landis Place on King apartments are rental units. Residents may choose to add other Landis Communities services available to anyone living downtown, such as inhome care through Landis at Home (www.landisathome.org) and Graceful Transitions, a concierge ser-

vice that is part of Landis at Home, that can help with everything from coordinating moves and designing new spaces to home organization and closet changeovers.

There are only a few opportunities remaining to become a part of the Landis Place on King community. For a limited time, two-bedroom apartments are starting at \$1,995. Those who sign a lease before Aug. 31 will receive one free year of parking in one of Lancaster city's parking garages.
